(Hong Kong - 13 December 2024) – Panda tever is sweeping across Hong Kong! Following the flash exhibitions on the Avenue of Stars, "Panda Go! Fest HK", the largest panda exhibition in Hong Kong, makes a whirlwind landing at Ngong Ping 360. In partnership with WWF-Hong Kong (WWF) and organizer AllRightsReserved (ARR), Ngong Ping 360's volunteers will showcase over 700 adorable panda sculptures at Ngong Ping Village on 14 to 15 December, transforming Lantau Island into a panda paradise!

Five panda-themed cable cars featuring panda sculptures have made their debut, offering guests the opportunity to see the panda sculptures up close in these designated cable car cabins. In addition to the panda sculptures showcased at the Ngong Ping Village Pavilion and the "Ngong Ping 360 x Red A Christmas Dream Factory" exhibition area, and with the unexpected appearances of "PANDA GO! GUIDE" at Ngong Ping Village, over 700 pandas are on show, welcoming all Hong Kong residents and guests from all over to experience the unique charm of the pandas. A selfie gallery with exclusive panda photo frames will be available, with part of the proceeds being donated to WWF. Guests can also donate an extra HK\$20 to



hug a panda sculpture.

Some exhibits will remain on display until 1 January next year, offering guests the opportunity to enjoy a meaningful Christmas and New Year surrounded by nature, art, and conservation.

Additionally, the vibrant Christmas activities at Ngong Ping Village and the panda exhibitions will surely attract a wide range of guests with different interests."

Mr. SK Lam, Founder of the organizer of "Panda Go! Fest HK" AllRightsReserved, stated, "On the occasion of ARR's 10th anniversary in 2023, we planned a trilogy of projects, including the highly anticipated Rubber Duck and Doraemon event, with the third part being pandas. At that time, we were unaware that Hong Kong would welcome new pandas, but this project now holds special significance with their arrival. We are delighted to collaborate once again with Ngong Ping 360, hoping to attract more guests to the activities at the Ngong Ping 360."



Ms Nicole Wong, CEO of WWF-Hong Kong, called for public support in understanding the importance in wild giant panda conservation. "Ten years ago the '1600 Pandas World Tour in Hong Kong: Creativity Meets Conservation' exhibition was named after the number of existing wild pandas left on Earth. Thanks to continuously expanding and optimising panda conservation projects over the years, the number of wild giant pandas has increased to about 1,900 today. Although the result is encouraging, giant pandas are still at risk and they are facing habitat loss from increased illegal logging. Protecting their habitat is paramount to the future of wild pandas. As a significant umbrella species, protecting wild pandas also represents the preservation of healthy ecosystems. I would like to express my gratitude to Ngong Ping 360 and AllRightsReserved for this meaningful collaboration. Every bit of your support becomes a powerful force in protecting and restoring our natural environment."

Photo Spot 1: PANDA GO! Flash Exhibition at Ngong Ping Village with the Big Buddha



From 14 to 15 December, Ngong Ping Village will host a panda-themed art festival. In the square next to the Village archway, 628 adorable panda sculptures have been arranged in circle, posing in various cute poses for you to snap photo with.

This includes six exclusive Hong Kong IPs "The PFF HK Panda Hong Kong Family and Friends Club" inspired by Hong Kong's panda family, referencing the characteristics of Hong Kong's six giant pandas. The members include Mother "Ying Ying"; Father 'Lok Lok'; Brother 'An An'; Sister 'Ke ke' and panda babies 'Elder Sister' and 'Little Brother'. For the first time ever, they will share the same stage with PANDA GO! Pandas with the Big Buddha. This combines the extraordinary charm of pandas with Hong Kong's natural culture against the backdrop of Lantau Island's enchanting scenery, showcasing the beauty of harmony between nature and art.

Five Ngong Ping Cable Cars have transformed into panda-themed cabins, featuring lazy pandas lounging on the grass and beside bamboo forests. These adorable pandas can accompany you as you enjoy the stunning scenery of Lantau Island. For the first time, sculptures have been placed inside the cabins, with each of the five themed cable cars showcasing an exquisite and cute panda sculpture. This allows guests to experience world-class cable car service while being able to interact closely with the pandas as they travel through the air together¹.

As a major tourist attraction located on Lantau Island in Hong Kong, Ngong Ping 360 offers guests an exciting and unique natural and cultural experience. The Ngong Ping Cable Car stretches 5.7 km from Tung Chung to Ngong Ping and is the longest bicable cable car system in Asia. It offers a visually spectacular 25-minute journey with panoramic views of the flora and fauna of North Lantau Country Park, Tung Chung Bay, the Hong Kong–Zhuhai–Macao Bridge and Hong Kong International Airport.

In 2022, Ngong Ping 360 launched "Crystal+", a new type of cabin developed in France and Italy. All sides and the bottom of the "Crystal+" cabin are made of fully transparent tempered glass, providing our guests with 80% visibility and an



unobstructed 360° panoramic view of Lantau Island to create an extraordinary travel experience.
